Ron noted that the current trailer can't accommodate the two mowers. He will explore trading up. Niverville storeage area needs to be modified for easier access with trailer.

Ron reported that Dave Booth of North Chatham is concerned that people accessing parking at that trail head are cutting over his lawn. We note that it is a confusing intersection. Ron suggests we keep the brush there trimmed back as best we can.
